



Crown / Bridge Post Treatment Care Instructions

Temporary Crown / Bridge

Temporary crown is needed to protect the tooth and maintain the space. Sensitivity and drifting of the teeth can occur if the temporary crown has fall off, which may lead to the final crown not fitting in place. Please call us immediately if your temporary crown or bridge falls off.

Precautions:

- Avoid sticky foods (chewy gums, caramel etc.).
- Avoid hard foods.
- Daily brushing and flossing are essential for healthy gums. When flossing, slide the floss material out instead of lifting it out to prevent pull off the temporary crown.

Permanent Crown / Bridge

Precautions:

- To attain optimum strength, the cement needs about 24 hours to mature. Do not chew on hard foods for the next 24 hours from the time they are cemented.
- Continue routine brushing and flossing on the same day. When flossing on the first day, slide the floss material out instead of lifting it out.
